Quorum of Members: Laura Kosik announced there were 166 attending [by end of meeting, there was 185]. We therefore had a quorum.

Minutes Approval: Mike asked all to review the February 24 & March 3, 2017, General Membership minutes. Margot Jordan made a motion to approve the February minutes, seconded by Nancy Van Siclen; motion carried. Joella Deakins made a motion to approve the March minutes, seconded by Betty Yerxa, motion carried.

UF Museum: Joe Wood announced that this year was the 20th anniversary of the Canal Museum and in 2012, they transferred the Museum to the University of Florida, Smathers Libraries. The Museum started out with 800-900 members but has only 168 members now. It is only \$26 a year so join! The Museum raised \$9,848 in membership. The Silent Auction closes at 3:30 on Saturday; last year the auction made about \$6K. Next year, there is a fund-raising cruise to Cuba and the Museum sells replicas of the Roosevelt Medals for a fund raiser. All funds go to digitizing, preserving and processing our collection. John Nemmers, a UF curator of the PC Museum took to the stage. He expounded on the care of our heritage which will be preserved and put out to the world. UF tracks how many 'hits' the website has created; from Jan-May 2018, there were 2.5 million views. Most viewed were Panama America exhibit, Yearbooks, Spillway and the Annual Reports from the Canal Zone. UF is finding ways to promote our Museum by awarding traveling grants and for those who want to research both the exhibit on-line and to the Gallery. In 2019, there are big events in our history – 20^{th} anniversary of the transfer of the Canal; 30^{th} of Just Cause; 40^{th} of the Treaties; 55^{th} year of the '64 riots and the 500^{th} anniversary of Panama. The next PCS/UF/Friends luncheon will be held on March 16, 2019.
